# Beaufort favourites to carry on the 2021 trend against Na Gaeil

IT is a game that would take centre stage most weekends except it has been trumped by the all Tralee SFC Final and rightly so but Na Gaeil would like to be up there with Austin Stacks and Kerins O'Rahilly's in the town of Tralee and they might well be shortly after 3pm today.

But Beaufort has similar ambitions so today's IFC final promises to be a cracker and it could go either way. Beaufort are favourites but despite being missing key personnel it would be foolish to write off Na Gaeil. However the stats and trends favour Beaufort because in 2021 both teams who lost the 2020 finals have gone to win the 2021 versions. In the 2020 Junior Premier Final Gneeveguilla lost in dramatic circumstances to Ballydonoghue in September but last month they gained compensation by

defeating Skellig Rangers in the 2021 final. In late August Castlegregory lost out by a wide margin to neighbours Annascaul in the 2020 Junior Final but again they regrouped and reached the 2021 final where they took Firies apart, proving again that they didn't want to suffer the pain of another final defeat.

So that brings us on nicely to the 2020 Intermediate Final where Spa blitzed Beaufort and had enough in the tank to withstand a stirring second half Beaufort comeback. So instead of folding their tent, Beaufort harnessed the hurt of that defeat and are back in the final so will history repeat itself and make it a hattrick of wins for teams who competed in two finals in the one year because of Covid.

While the Na Gaeil players were helping St. Brendan's to a SFC semi-final only to lose out to Austin Stacks in the most heartbreaking circumstances, Beaufort

were winning two Mid Kerry SFC games and are poised to play Laune Rangers in the final.

So the preparations of both sides have been markedly different and well though the Na Gaeil contingent played with St. Brendan's, nothing beats playing as a team so its advantage Beaufort on that front.

There is history between the sides

as they met just three months ago in the semi-final of the 2020 IFC and Beaufort came out on top. So today's final will mark the fourth Championship meeting between the sides over the last five years with Beaufort leading 2-1 and that includes the 2018 Premier Junior Final that saw Beaufort get up from the canvas on a couple of occasions before going on to win an epic in extra time (4-13 to 2-18). Both sides have won All-Ireland Club titles so it is clear that both have quality and there should be very little in it.

Beaufort have no major injuries and their manager Eanna O'Malley reflects on how their preparations have gone. "I feel while losing the final to Spa hurt, we were more disappointed to lose to Rathmore in the opening round of the Club Championship the week after. Everything else was knockout after that and we had to regroup to win our next two games and make the quarters" he said. They then beat Kilcummin and Rathmore who were senior sides back in 2019 and this was another feather in their can

This is their fifth game in Fitzgerald Stadium since last year so it is a home for them so they will have no fears of the venue. Beaufort has a very strong side but they will be relying for big games from Mike Breen, Sean O'Brien, Ronan Murphy, Liam Carey, Cian Dennehy and Jack O'Connor.

Na Gaeil has a number of issues preparing for this game and in fact their preparations were badly impeded by nine players being involved with St. Brendan's in their SFC run to the semi-finals. Then they were hit with an injury to their main man Diarmuid O'Connor who did serious damage to his hand and if absent, then this could be a mortal blow to their chances of winning. Then throw in a wedding which takes their captain Eoin Doody and wing forward Kieran Finch O'Donovan

out of the mix (Best Man and Groomsman man at a friend's wedding) and one can see that Na Gaeil are in trouble with naming their best starting fifteen.

But any side that has the three Barry brothers - Jack, Andrew and Fergal, Stefan Okunbor, Enda O'Connor, Damien Bourke, Devon Burns, Dan Goggin and Darragh Carmody are a side that might well raise their game for absent friends and give the final a right rattle.
